Check-in will depend on whether you chose a 2 or 3-day track.

- Full 3 Day Experience: Friday, October 6 between 2:00-3:00 PM
- 2 Day Option: Saturday, October 7 between 9:00-10:00 AM

Check-out Sunday around 11:00 AM (for both 3 or 2 day options)

Camp Out: 3-day attendees will campout Friday night (weather allowing). You will need to bring your campout gear in a separate small bag (covered by a trash bag). Please bring a headlamp, small towel, swimsuit, water bottle, insect repellent, and sleeping bag. You may choose to bring your own tent, but please remember space is limited in the canoe. Truett will be providing tarps to sleep under.

Linens: Please bring your own suitable for a twin-sized bed as well as any other necessary towels/toiletries.

Lodging: You will be staying in bunkhouse-style lodging with other campers.
(Each room has 2 private showers, toilets, and sinks)

Camp Store: Snacks and camp merchandise will be available for sale. (Cash/cards accepted)

What Else to Bring: Your Bible, a watch, a pocket or sheath knife, pen, headlamp/flashlight. October weather covers a wide range of possibilities, so please dress/pack accordingly.
